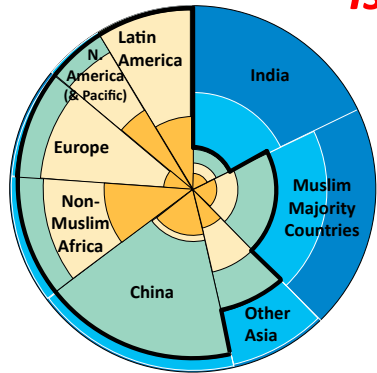


The *Awareness* Problem: The World's *Overlooked* Peoples

One in 4 people in the world live in a Frontier People Groups (FPG).
 Among these FPGs, less than 1 in 1,000 identify with Jesus.
 Starting Jesus movements in FPGs is a *finishable* task.
 < 1 of 100 laborers work toward movements among FPGs.

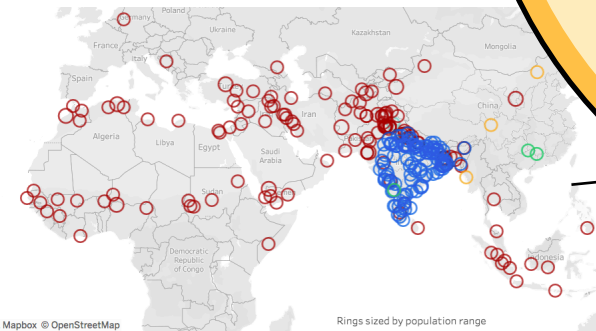
The other 3 in 4 live alongside 99 of 100 believers and churches.
 Most non-believers here can meet believers and join a church.
 Evangelism of those with such gospel access is a *never-ending* task.
 99 of 100 laborers work in *partnership* with existing churches.

Is God calling YOU to help spread awareness of these overlooked FPGs?

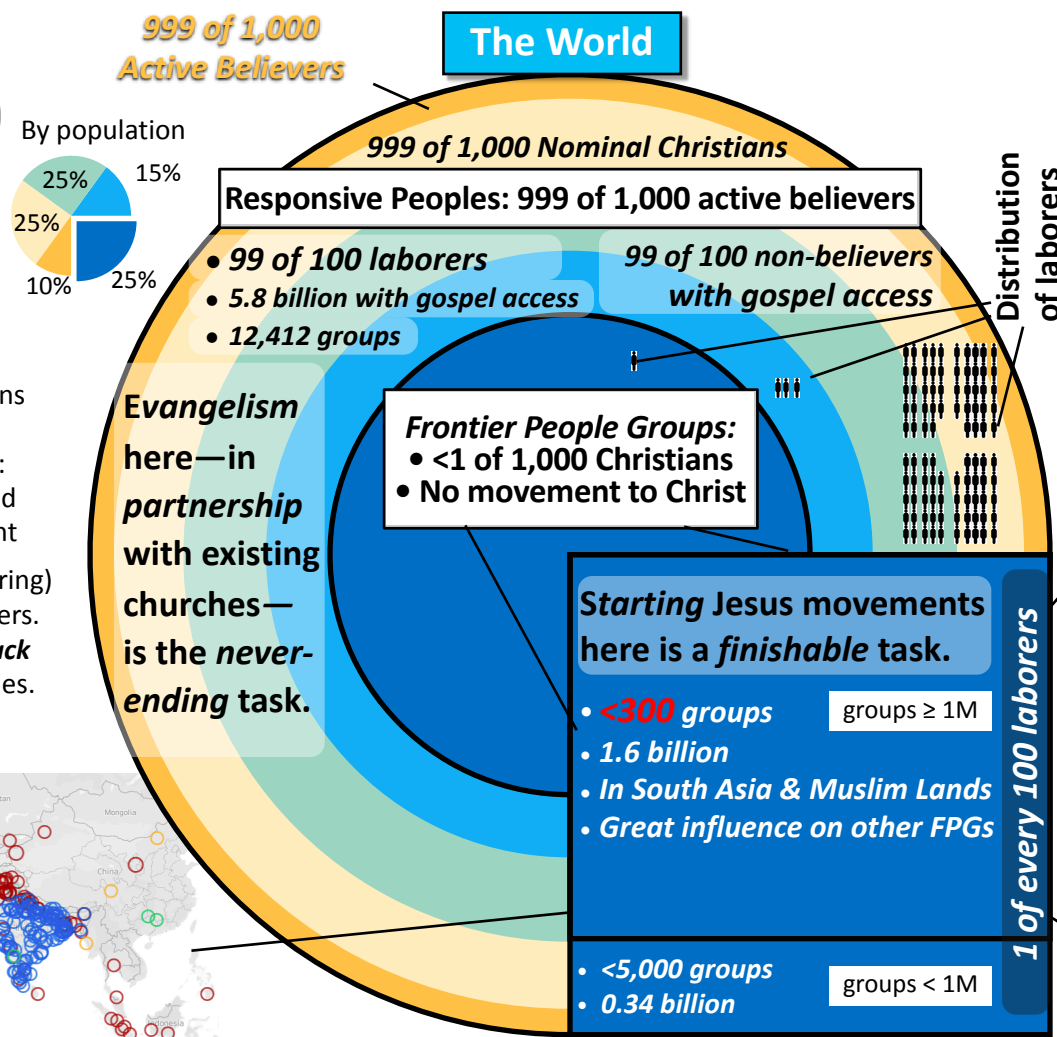


- Active Believers

- Frontier non-Christians: ≤ 1 Christian/1,000, and no sustained movement

Frontier People Groups (center ring) are **isolated** from active believers. Active believers (outer ring) **lack awareness** of Frontier peoples.
